LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1960.

The Municipality of the Shire of Wanneroo.

By-Laws Relating to Parking Facilities.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the abovementioned Act and all other powers enabling it, the Council of the Shire of Wanneroo hereby records having resolved on 28 September 1983, to make and submit for confirmation by the Governor the following amendments to its by-laws relating to parking facilities as published in the *Government Gazette* on 8 May 1981.

1. By-law 2:
 - (a) insert the words "or other area where designated" after the word "carriageway" in line 1 of the definition "no parking area";
 - (b) insert the words "or other area where designated" after the word "carriageway" in line 1 of the definition "no standing area";
 - (c) insert the following definition after the definition "Traffic Act":—
"verge" means a portion of a street that lies between a carriageway and the nearest street boundary.
